7. ATV Routes – discussion and possible action to revise Bayfield County ATV Routes.
 - a. Ashland County allows ATV traffic on all County Highways except CTH GG and CTH A. Sawyer County is in discussions about opening their highways to ATV traffic. Douglas County allows ATV traffic on all CTH's unless they are posted otherwise. Does Bayfield County wish to follow Douglas County's process?
 - b. Since ATV routes have been established, we haven't witnessed accidents from their use of the highways. Although this is contrary to what one may think at first, I am in support of this change. This would allow us to spend less time on ATV route signage and spend our resources in other needed areas.

8. ATV Routes – discussion and possible action to open the below routes.
 - a. CTH A from Summit Street in Iron River to Kolling Road.
 - b. The Town of Mason would like the entire 12 mile stretch of CTH E from Ino to the Village of Mason to be open to ATV's.

10. Commissioner's Report
 - a. Construction update
 - i. CTH J and CTH I
 1. Contractor has completed paving on CTH J and CTH I. They are still working on striping and shouldering but should be finishing up soon.
 - ii. USH 63 – Drummond to CTH E East
 1. Work has been started focusing on replacing culverts.
 2. Project completion should be the last week in October.
 3. Gravel will be added to smooth low spots in bibon swamp.
 4. Single lane closures.
 - iii. USH 63 – CTH E East to USH 2
 1. Contractor has completed paving and will install rumble strips, striping and shouldering.
 - iv. Delta Landfill Project
 1. Work continues and crew is placing erosion products with a definite showing of progress.
 2. We estimate the project will be finishing up in September/October.
