- ii. Delta Landfill Project
 1. Work continues and crew is placing erosion products with a definite showing of progress.
 2. We estimate the project will be finishing up in October.
- iii. Winter preparations
 1. We have been working on getting all plows serviced and ready for plowing.
 2. We have placed our order for early fill salt that will be provided to the towns.
 3. Working to setup a trial section using a commercial product to reduce salt usage.
