 - a. Continue discussion of opening County Highways with exceptions to ATV traffic. Towns were requested to send their input at the Town's Association Meeting on September 29, 2022 via email.

7. County Bridge Aid – discussion and possible action on County Bridge Aid.
 - a. In 2021, the Town of Kelly requested \$4,500 in Bridge Aid to replace a culvert on Brown Road. They submitted a reimbursement request for \$8,737 due to the project cost being \$17,474. Does the committee recommend we increase the funding by \$4,237 and match the 50% share? To date \$5,502.94 has been approved for reimbursement from the FY21 County Bridge Aid funds and \$6,383.63 for FY22 out of \$133,340.

a. Construction update

i. USH 63 – Drummond to CTH E East

1. Contractor anticipates completing all paving this week. They will then move onto installing rumble strips and striping. Should be wrapped up within two weeks.

ii. Delta Landfill Project

1. Work has been completed! We are beginning to prepare the close-out package for reimbursement.

iii. Winter preparations

1. We held our Fall Staff Meeting on November 27th and calibrated our sanders/salt spreaders.
2. We plan to perform a trial using Skyline Salt Solutions products beginning in January. WisDOT has agreed to partner with us.
