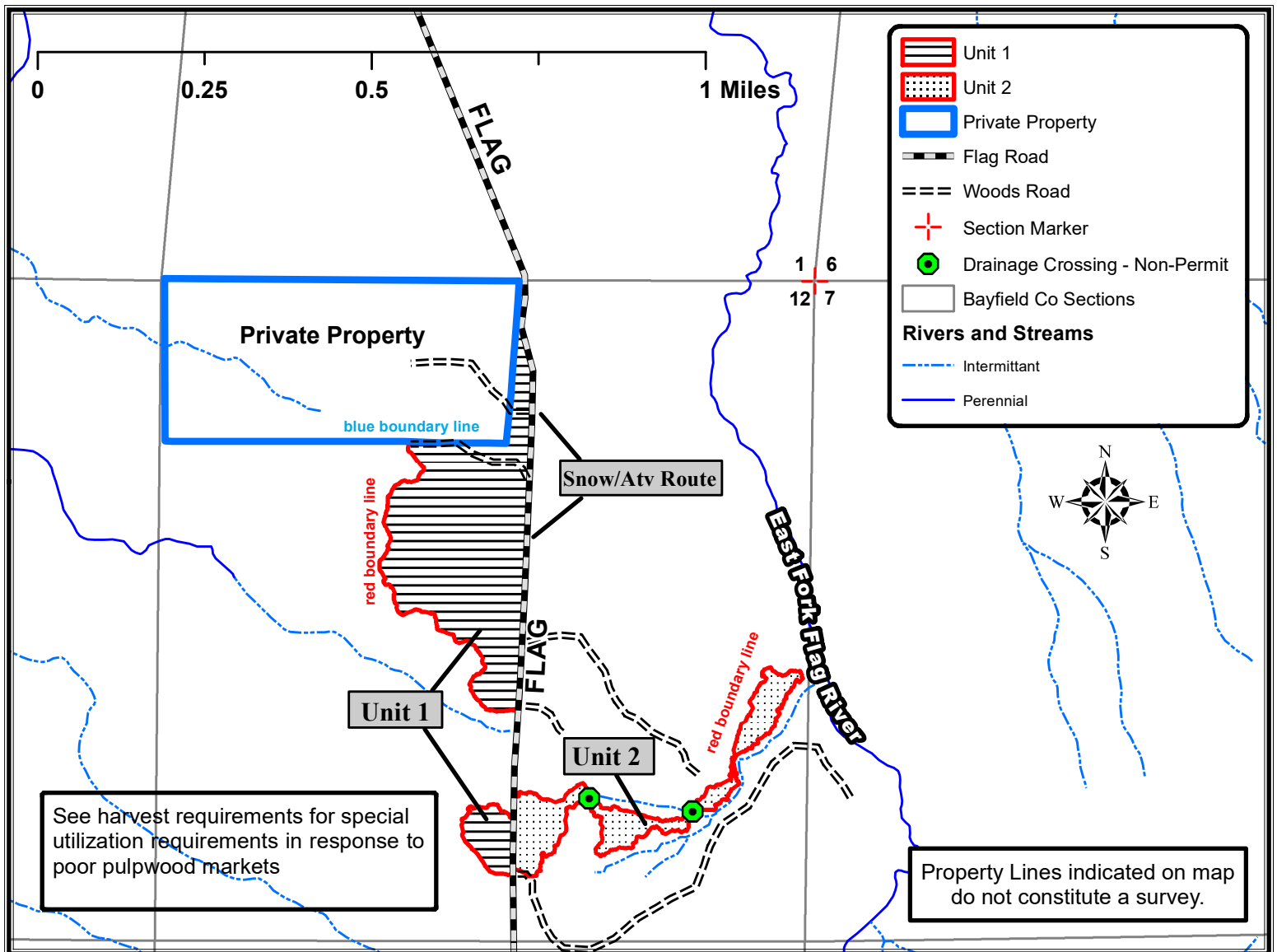

# TRACT 33-20 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

## A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. Unit 1 – Clear cut to prepare to convert to red pine. The designated harvest area contains a residual area of 1%. This percent of the total area includes white pine, red pine, and white oak legacy trees.
2. Unit 2 – Seed Tree Harvest. The designated harvest area contains a residual area of 18%. This percent of the total area includes red oak reserves.

## B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

1. Unit 1 – Sever all stems 2" in diameter and greater EXCEPT: Trees marked with purple paint
2. Unit 2 – Sever all stems 2" in diameter and greater EXCEPT: Trees marked with purple paint

## C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS and SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

1. Harvest only during dry or frozen conditions, as determined by Bayfield County.
2. In 2018, oak wilt was officially confirmed in Bayfield County. Currently, this timber sale is located more than six miles away from the closest known infected tree. However, over the duration of this contract, additional infections could be discovered. If, over the duration of this contract, including extensions, oak wilt is officially confirmed within a six mile radius of this timber sale, as determined by the county, the following seasonal restriction will be applied: no harvesting operations will be allowed between April 15<sup>th</sup> (or as otherwise determined by the county) and July 15<sup>th</sup>.
3. Non-navigable areas of concentrated flow in stand 2 will require protection to cross, as indicated on the map, and determined by sale admin.
4. Sale boundaries are red paint lines as indicated on map.
5. Private property boundaries are blue paint as indicated on map. No equipment or logging slash should cross the private boundary.
6. If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.

## D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

1. Flagg Road is a county forest road and is not plowed. Snow removal will be the responsibility of the purchaser.
2. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places other requirements on road construction and closure.
3. Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
4. During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles. Avoid damage to signs and trail markers.

## E. OTHER:

1. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
2. All logging slash is to be removed from drainages and crossings before sale completion.
3. Do not damage survey monumentation. Any monumentation will be marked for avoidance by Bayfield County.
4. Utilization specification is to a 4" top. However, if the County determines that pulpwood markets continue to be very poor at the time of harvest the County will sign a contract amendment with the purchaser changing the utilization specification to a 5" top for selected species. When determining condition of the market, the County will pay attention to the amount of wood being purchased by the mills in Wisconsin Rapids and any other significant shifts in wood demand.
