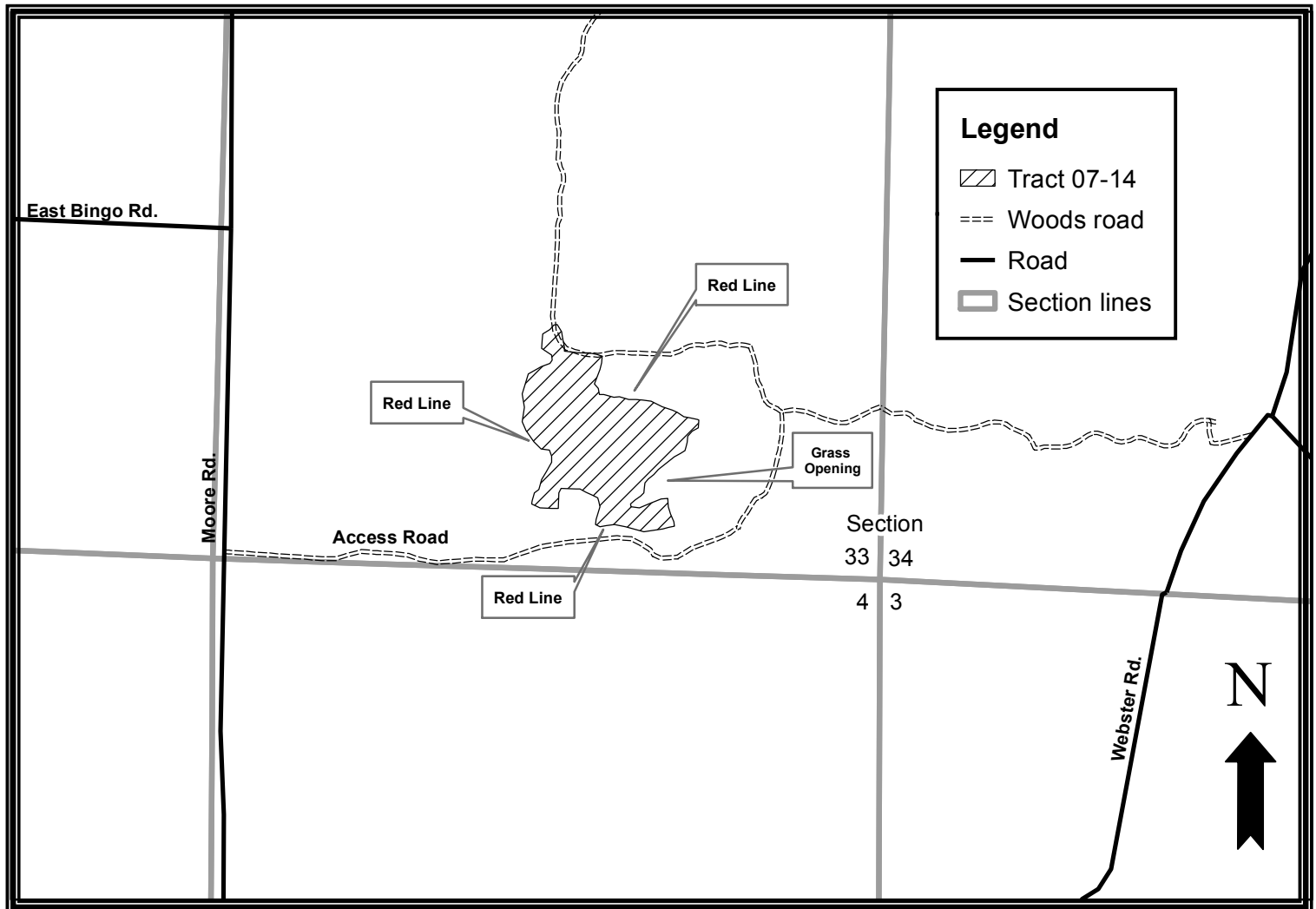

## Harvest requirements:

- Sale is being sold on a ticket scale basis. Whole-tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will be allowed.
- If sale is whole tree harvested, 1 in 10 tops <4" in diameter must be left scattered across the site.
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint lines or an abrupt change in timber type.
- Cut all trees within the sale area down to 2 inches DBH.
- Prior to moving equipment to and from the sale area, scrape soil and debris from exterior surfaces.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction, and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>.
