

- > This 28-acre sale is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis. The sale has two units: a 15-acre unit of patch clearcuts in northern hardwoods and a 13-acre clearcut in red manle/aspen/oak
- > Sale may be accessed from Butterfield Rd. (Option "A") or Lost Lake Rd. (Option "B"). From Butterfield Rd 0.9 miles of existing trail will need to be widened and improved, and 800 ft. will need to be pioneered. From Lost Lake Rd. 1,100 ft. of existing trail must be improved by crowning, ditching, and installing 2-12" culverts in locations determined by the Sale Administrator.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a snow-packed condition. The purchaser must insure that the harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard for snowmobilers. Trail must be appropriately signed.
- > Construct new interior trails (marked with orange paint) to access some of the patches. Only harvest trees marked with orange paint when constructing the new trails. A short segment of existing trail will be abandoned to protect tree regeneration. Build new trail around it (see map).
- > Sale boundaries are formed by the trail on the sale's western edge, by red paint, and by purple paint around patch clearcuts.
 - PRESCRIPTION: PATCH CLEARCUTS: *HARVEST* all merchantable hardwoods and merchantable fir/spruce: *SEVER* all submerchantable ironwood 1" and larger. *LEAVE* all other conifers, all submerchantable hardwoods besides ironwood, and submerchantable fir/spruce. CLEARCUT: *HARVEST* all merchantable hardwoods and merchantable fir/spruce: *SEVER* all submerchantable hardwoods 2" in diameter and larger. *LEAVE* all other conifers, all trees marked with purple paint, and submerchantable fir/spruce.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- > To comply with the BMPs for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- > This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
