

TRACT 03-18 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

- 1. Harvest unit 1 has a seed tree prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 9 ft².
- 2. Harvest unit 2 has an overstory removal prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 10 ft².
- 3. Harvest unit 3 has a coppice with reserves prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 9 ft².

B. HARVESTING REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. In unit 1, cut all hardwood stems 2 inches in diameter and greater not marked with purple paint.
- 2. In unit 1, leave all conifer and all purple marked trees
- 3. In unit 2, harvest all hardwood stems 6 inches in diameter and greater not marked with purple paint.
- 4. In unit 2, leave all conifer and all purple marked trees.
- 5. In unit 3, harvest all hardwood stems 2 inches in diameter and greater not marked with purple paint.
- 6. In unit 3, leave all conifer and all purple marked trees.

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- 1. In unit 3, sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen.
- 2. There may be wet areas within the sale boundary. Care must be taken to avoid these areas unless the ground is frozen.
- 3. Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, blue paint line and roads.
- 4. In unit 2, care must be taken to avoid damage to advanced regeneration.
- 5. Unit 2 is restricted to short wood logging only.
- 6. The blue paint line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
- 7. Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- 8. Do not cut snags except for individuals that pose a safety hazard.
- 9. If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- 10. From May 19th to October 16th care should be taken to avoid open sandy areas with equipment and felled trees due to the possible presence of a rare animal.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- 1. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

E. OTHER:

- This sale includes 8 trees that are painted with a purple 'X". Operator must fell and leave all trees marked with a purple "X". "X" marked trees should be cut 5 feet above ground level and should lie as close to the high stump as possible. These trees will create ruffed grouse drumming habitat.
- To comply with Best Management
 Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to
 moving equipment onto or off the
 sale area, scrape or brush soil and
 debris from exterior surfaces to the
 extent practical.
