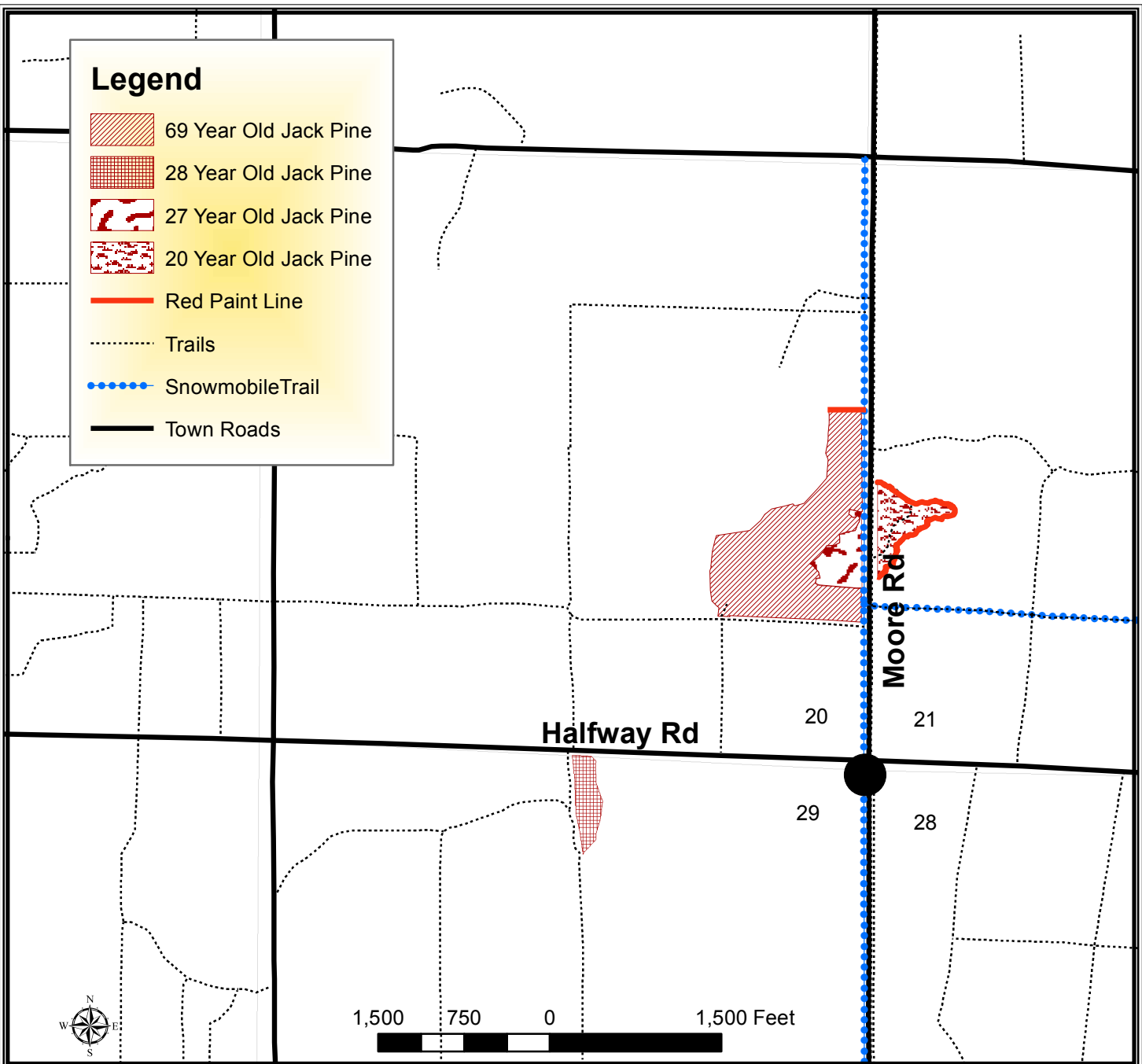

TRACT 18-18 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. All harvest units have a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft².

B. TREES DESIGNATED FOR CUTTING:

1. In all units harvest all stems 2 inches and greater.

C. TREES DESIGNATED FOR LEAVING:

1. None

D. HARVEST AND OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
2. If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.

E. SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

1. Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.

F. ACCESS AND ROADS:

1. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
2. Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

G. OTHER:

1. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
