

## **TRACT 19-18 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS**

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

### A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. Harvest unit 1 has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 2 ft<sup>2</sup>.

## **B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. In unit 1, harvest all hardwood stems and balsam fir stems 2" and greater.
- 2. In Unit 1, leave all conifer except balsam fir.

## C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- 1. Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, Flag Rd., or game openings.
- 2. Do not deck wood or disturb soil in game openings indicated on map.
- 3. During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- 4. If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- 5. Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen or during exceptionally dry conditions as determined by Bayfield County.
- 6. Do not cut snags except for individuals that pose a safety hazard.

#### D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- 1. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- 2. Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

### E. OTHER:

- 1. This sale includes 4 trees that are painted with a purple 'X". Operator must fell and leave all trees marked with a purple "X". "X" marked trees should be cut 5 feet above ground level and should lie as close to the high stump as possible. These trees will create ruffed grouse drumming habitat.
- 2. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
