- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, blue paint line, recent harvest, or Happy Hollow Rd.
- The blue paint line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
- Oak Thinning: Harvest all orange marked trees and all aspen and birch 2" and greater. No sale operations allowed between breakup and July 1st.
- Aspen Clearcut: Leave all conifer and purple marked trees. Harvest all unmarked hardwoods stems 2" and greater. In this unitonly, sale operations my only occur when the ground is frozen unless written permission is granted by Bayfield County.
- ➤ Oak Seed Tree: Leave all purple marked trees and all conifer except harvest all balsam fir 4" and greater. Harvest all unmarked hardwood stems 2" and greater.
- > Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- > Approximately ½ mile of existing road will need improvement (See attached Happy Hollow Road Project Map for specifications), contractor will be responsible for these imporvements.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- > To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
