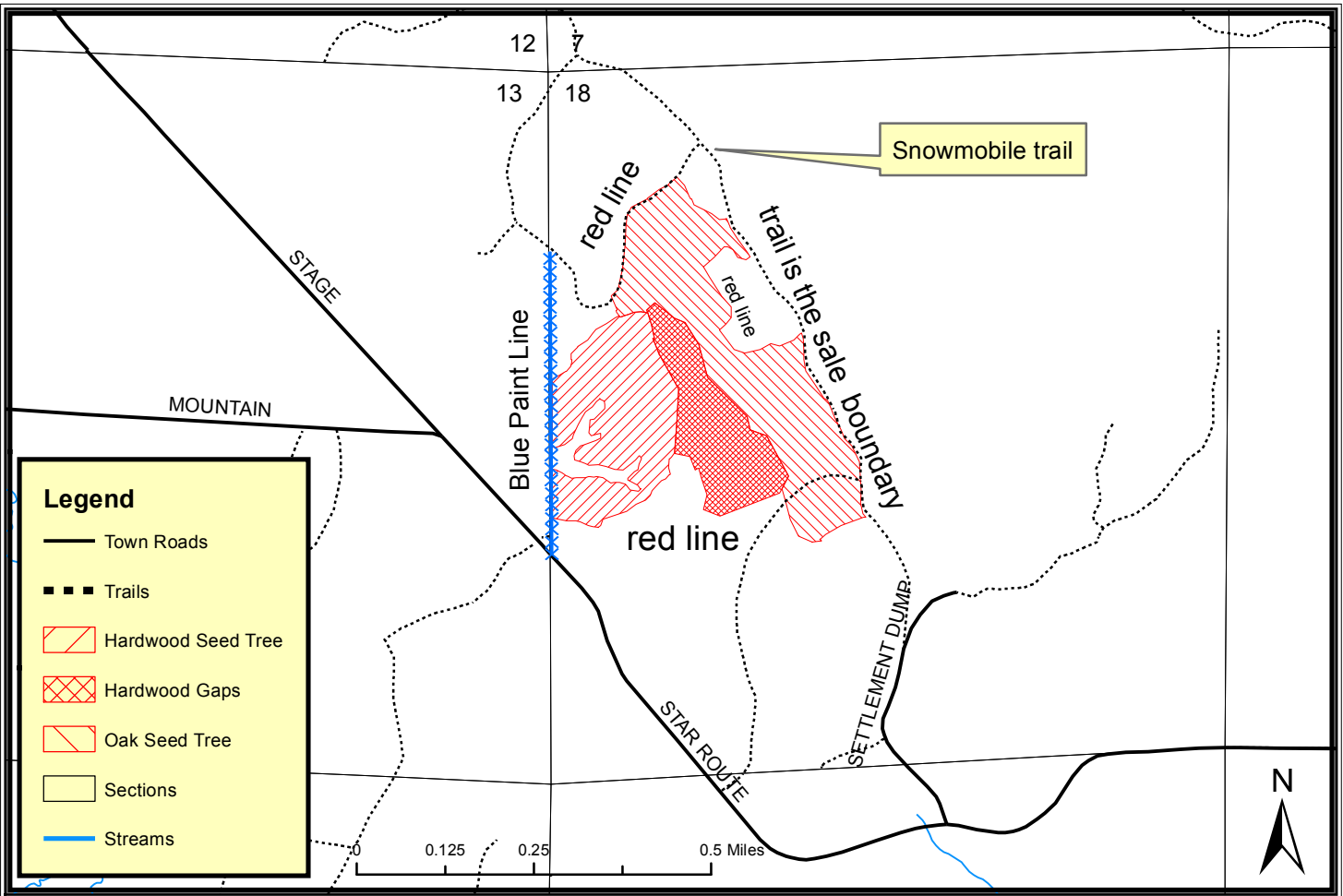

- Harvest Requirements:**
- Sale will be sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
 - Access will be off Settlement Dump road
 - Sale boundaries and units are marked out in red paint and blue paint.
 - Sale includes different harvest units: Hardwood Seed Tree Unit, Oak Seed Tree Unit, Hardwood Gap Unit
 - **HARDWOOD SEED TREE UNIT:** Harvest all hardwoods and softwoods 2" in diameter and greater. Leave all purple painted trees. Leave all red pine, white pine, hemlock, and cedar. Harvest must occur during frozen or exceptional dry conditions as determined by Bayfield County in this unit.
 - **OAK SEED TREE UNIT:** Harvest all hardwoods and softwoods 4" in diameter and greater. Leave all purple painted trees. Leave all red pine, white pine, and hemlock.
 - **HARDWOOD GAP UNIT:** Harvest all hardwood and softwoods 2" in diameter and greater within the purple painted canopy gaps. There are no trees marked for removal between gaps. Contractor is responsible for navigating between gaps in such a way to minimize damage to residual trees. Minimal operational trees may be taken focusing on the smallest and lowest quality trees.
 - Main access road is also a snowmobile trail. During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles. Avoid damaging trail signs and markers.
 - Blue paint marks a change in ownership, so no equipment or trees may cross the blue paint line.
 - This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
 - Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard
 - To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
 - This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
