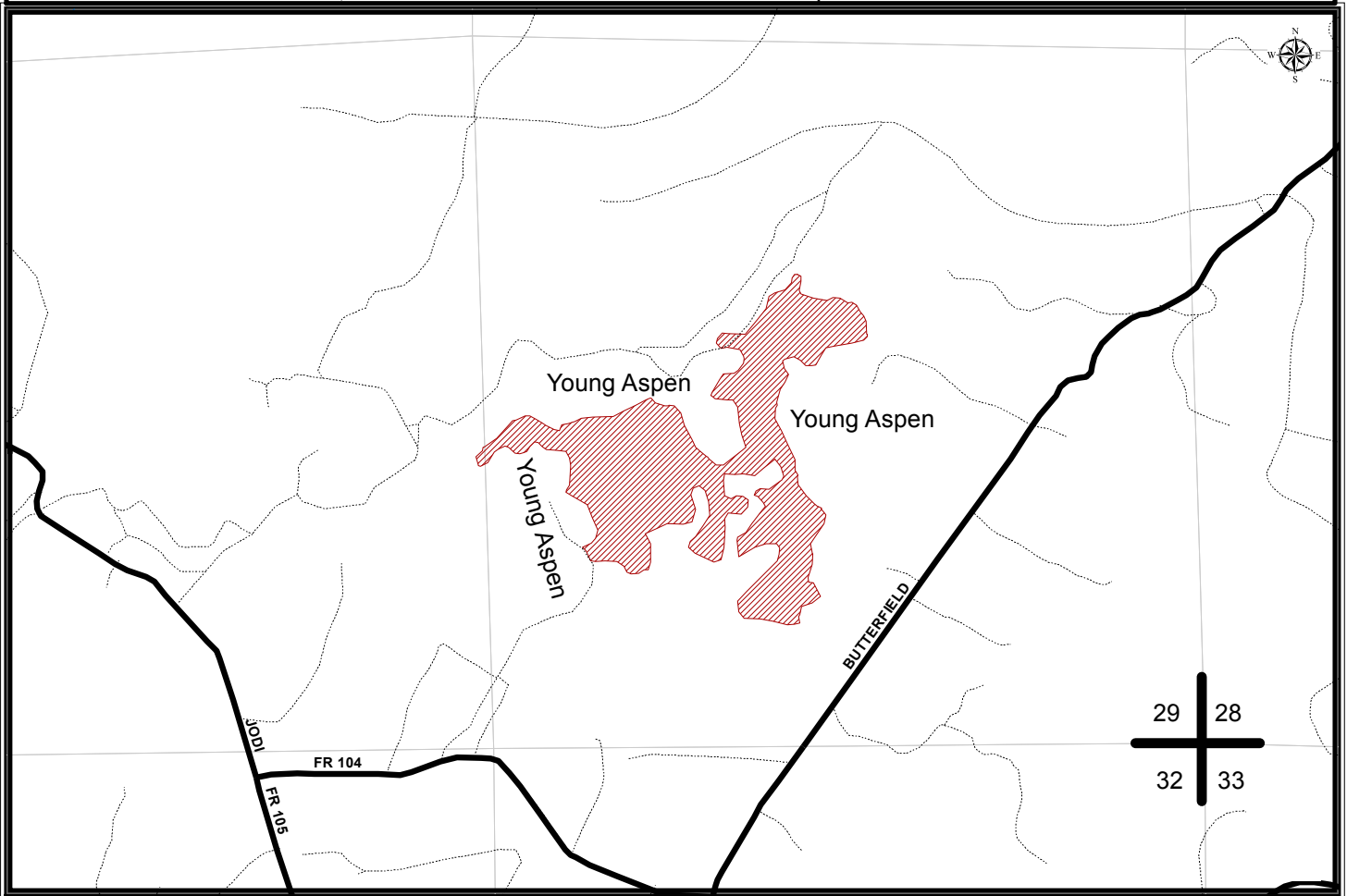

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a scrub oak clearcut being sold on a ticket scale basis.
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line around entire sale.
- Leave all purple marked oak and birch. Leave all conifer except, harvest all jack pine 4" and greater.
- Harvest all unmarked hardwood stems 2" and greater.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will not be allowed.
- According to the Bayfield County Access management plan the existing roads within this sale are open to highway vehicle use. Upon completion of the timber sale these roads will be left open unless otherwise directed by the sale administrator.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
