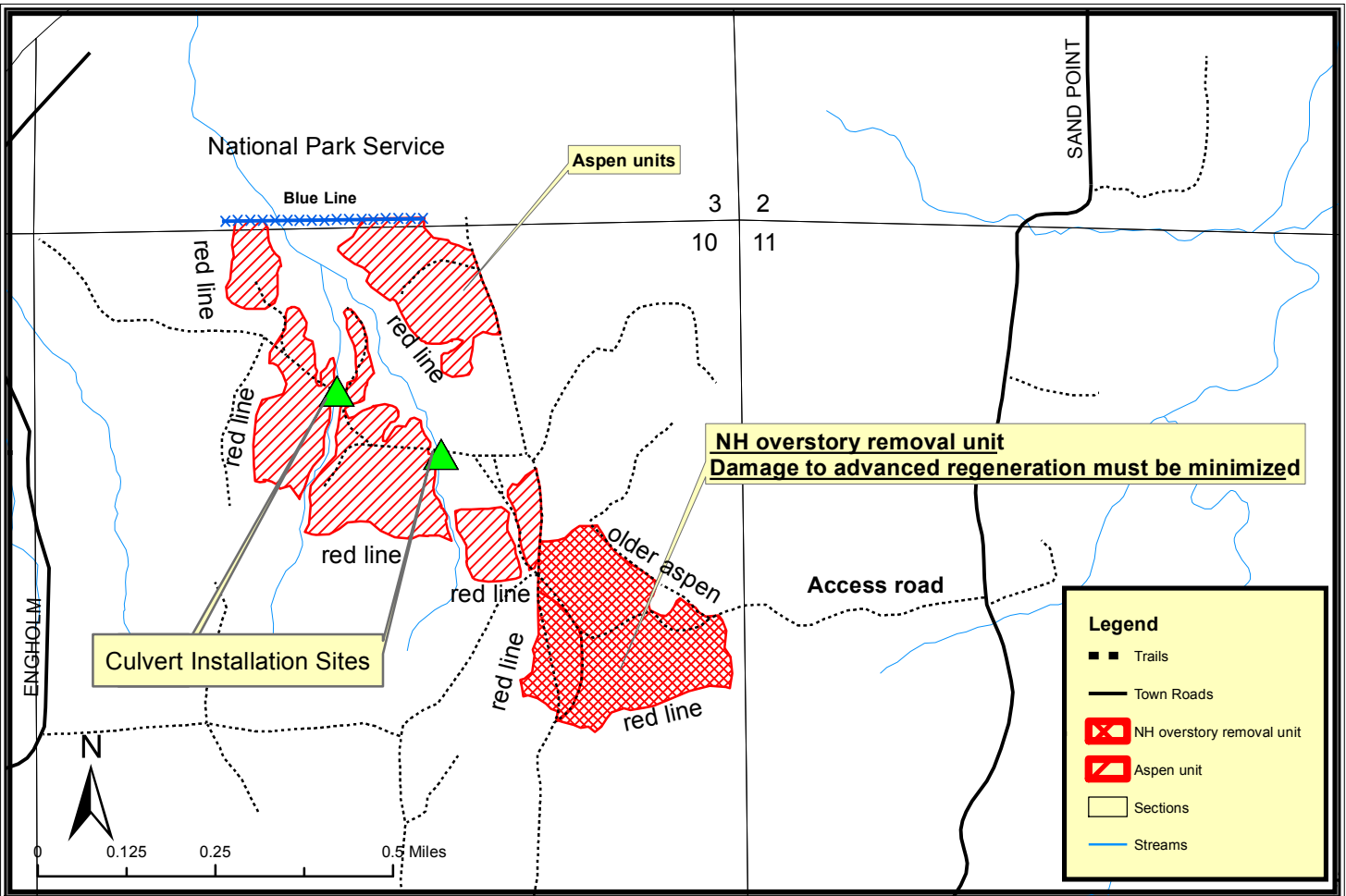

## Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is an aspen clearcut and hardwood overstory removal being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries include red paint line, blue paint line, and abrupt timber type changes.
- **HARDWOOD OVERSTORY REMOVAL UNIT:** Leave all trees marked with purple paint and all conifers. Harvest all other merchantable hardwoods. **Protect regeneration as much as possible.** Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard. Disregard the old orange paint on all trees.
- **ASPEN CLEARCUT UNIT:** Harvest all hardwoods and softwoods 2" in diameter and greater. There are 3 purple painted trees that have a large purple painted x on both sides of the tree with a purple painted ring 5 ft off the ground, which are grouse trees. These 3 grouse trees have specific harvesting requirements.
  - Harvest the tree above the purple painted ring and lay the cut portion of the tree on the ground as close to the high stump as possible.
- Harvesting may only occur during frozen or very dry ground conditions as determined by the sale administrator
- There are two water crossing locations, as noted on the map, where the contractor is responsible for removing the existing faulty culvert and installing an 18" culvert in accordance with the Wisconsin BMPs and under the direction of the sale administrator.
- Blue paint line indicates a change in ownership. No trees or equipment may cross the blue line except when using the access road.
- This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Do not damage any survey monuments.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
