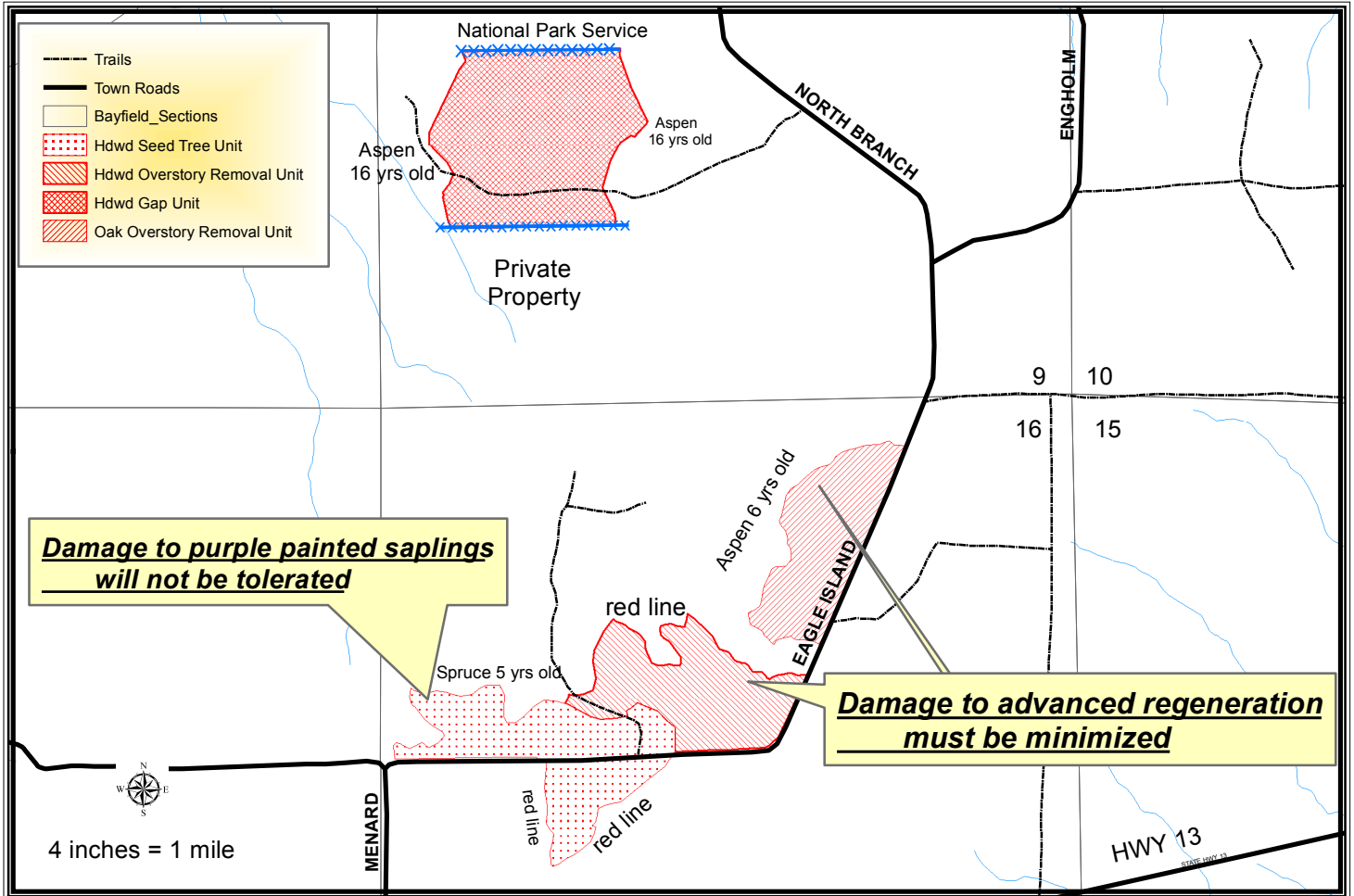

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a ticket sale being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries include: young aspen, young spruce/tamarack, red line, blue line, and town road
- **Hardwood Gap Unit:** Gaps are 1/3 acre in size. There are 10-12 purple painted trees on the perimeter with two dots facing in towards the gap with a purple slash on the backside of each tree. Harvest all trees 1" dbh and up within the purple painted gaps except cedar and hemlock. No trees are marked for removal outside of the gaps. Skid trails between gaps must be laid out to minimize harvest of merchantable wood. No sale operations permitted between breakup and July 15th.
- **Oak and Hardwood Overstory Removal Units:** Harvest all merchantable trees that are not painted purple. The point of this harvest is to release the young saplings that are present in the understory. **Minimize damage to the regeneration.**
- **Hardwood Seed Tree Unit:** Harvest all merchantable hardwood that is not painted purple. **Do not damage the purple painted saplings.** The eastern 2/3rd of this unit was scarified with a dozer to knock back the ironwood component. The western 1/3rd of this unit has excellent regeneration present. Minimize damage to this regeneration.
- No equipment or trees may cross the blue painted line
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure
