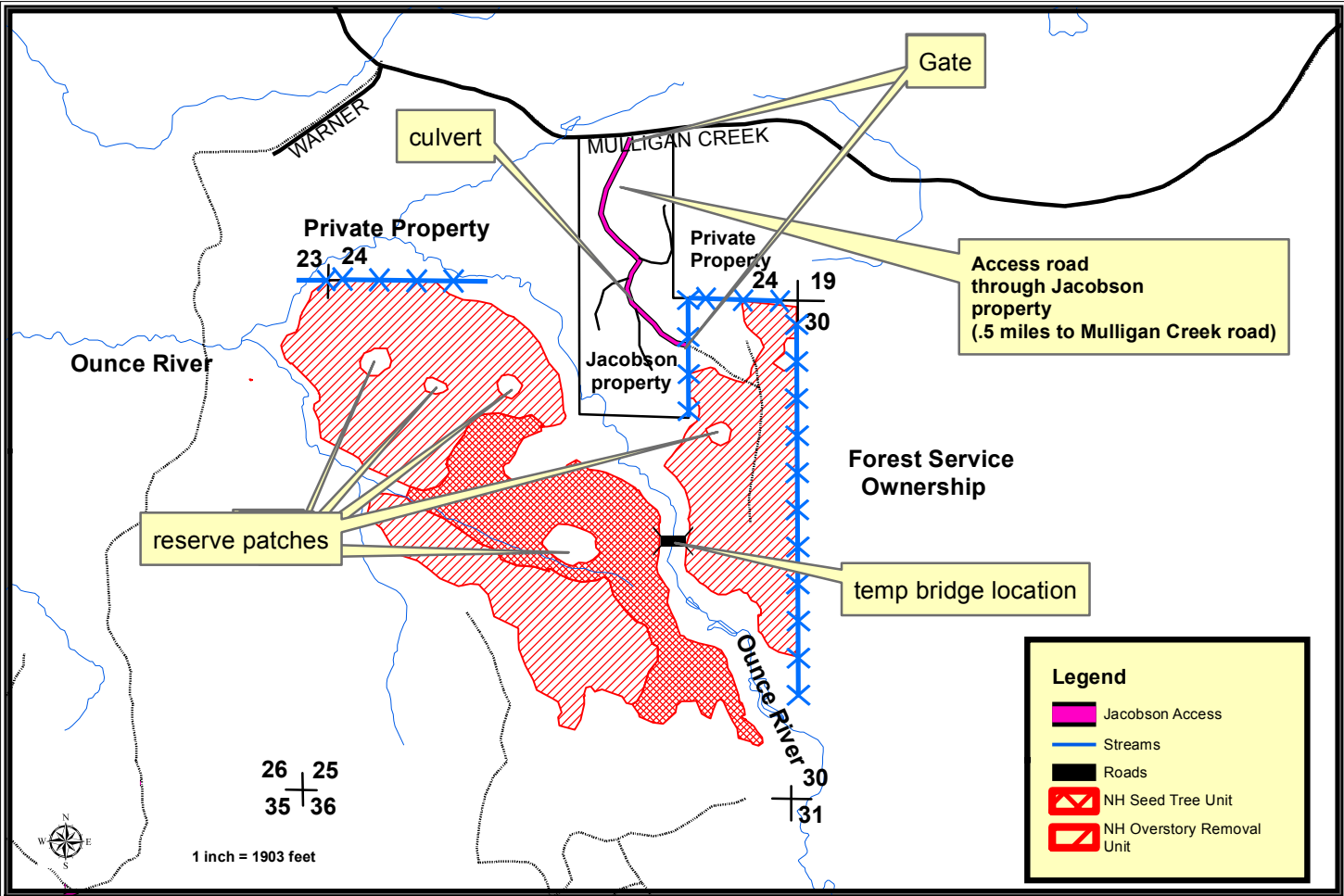

## Harvest Requirements:

- Sale will be sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries include: red line and blue line
- Northern Hardwood Overstory Removal Unit: Harvest all merchantable hardwood not painted in purple paint. Harvest all merchantable spruce and fir. Minimize damage to residual maple regeneration.
- Northern Hardwood Seed Tree Unit: Harvest all hardwood not painted purple. Harvest all merchantable spruce and fir. Sever all hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Do not harvest cedar, hemlock, or pine throughout entire sale.
- Sale must be harvested during frozen or dry soil conditions as determined by the sale administrator.
- Sale access is through private property. Access has been secured by the county. Road must be returned to as good or better condition prior to sale closeout as determined by Bayfield County. Gate must be closed and locked on days when hauling and harvesting will not take place. There is a 12" plastic culvert on private property that is buried shallow. Culvert needs to remain intact. Some trail widening may be needed. Contractor is responsible for damage on private land.
- Sale includes crossing a temporary bridge over the Ounce River. Bayfield County will install and remove bridge once contractor builds the road to the bridge installation site. County will assist with layout of new road to bridge installation site.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- No equipment or trees may cross the blue painted private line except for the purpose of hauling timber to the town road. This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
