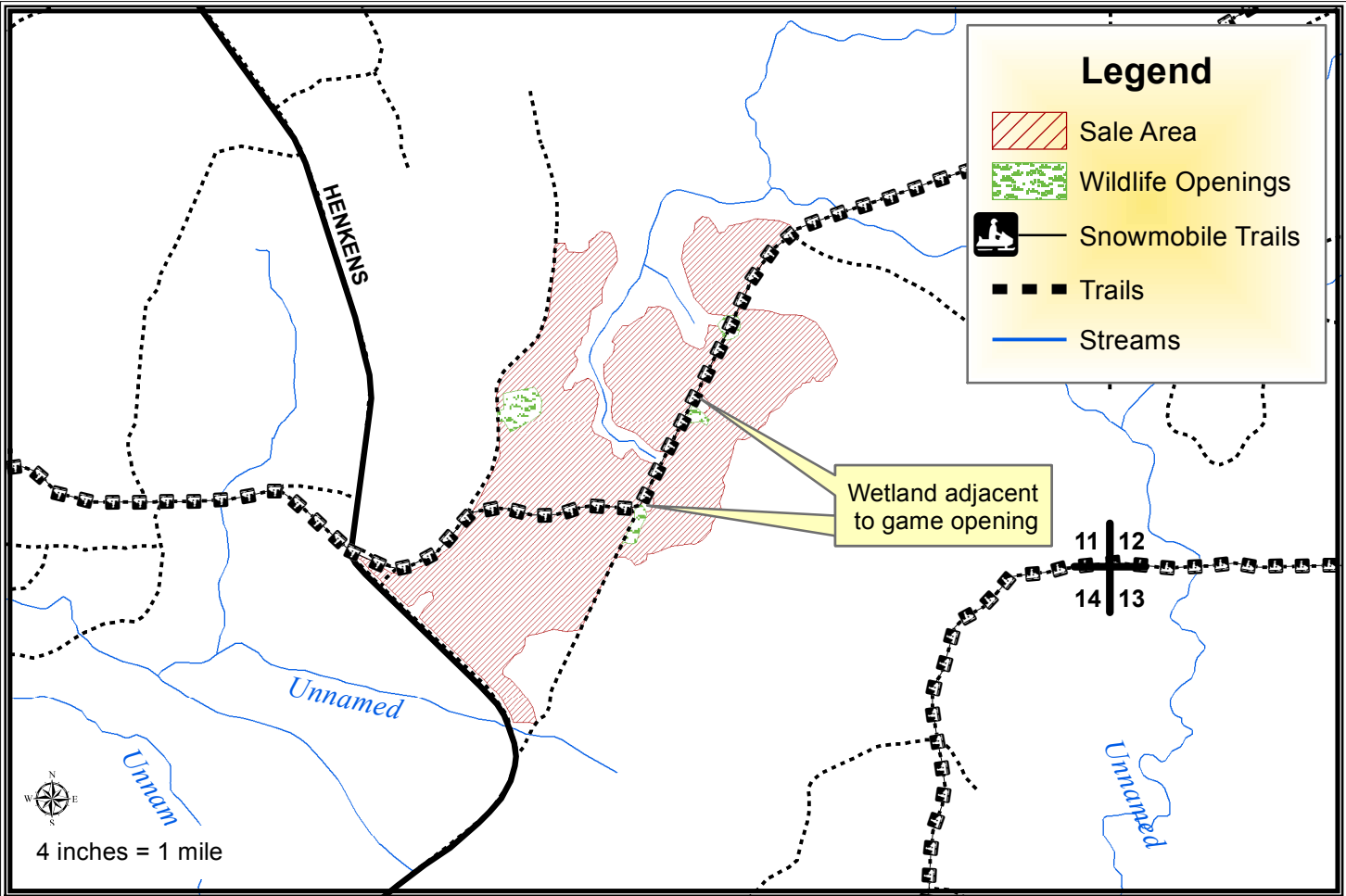

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a clearcut being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, trails, or wildlife openings.
- Leave all conifer except merchantable balsam fir and spruce.
- Harvest all merchantable hardwood and all merchantable balsam fir and spruce. Sever all hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Wildlife openings may not be used for any part of sale operations.
- Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen unless written permission is granted by Bayfield County.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must insure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
