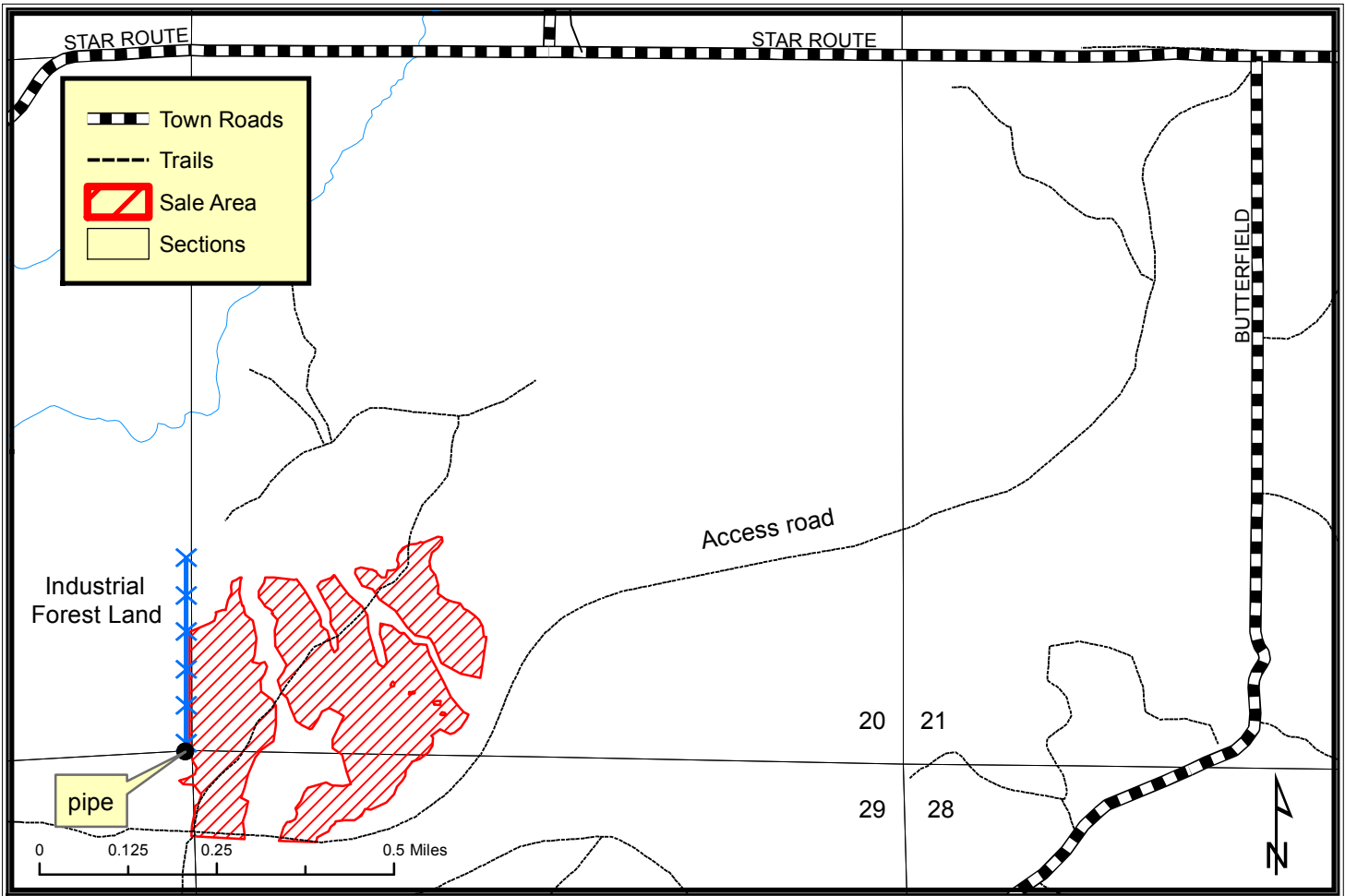

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a clearcut with reserves and will be sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries include a blue paint line on the west side. The trail is the southern boundary. The rest of the boundaries are marked out in red paint.
- Prescription: Clearcut: Leave all trees marked with purple paint and all hemlock, pine, and cedar. Harvest all unmarked, merchantable hardwoods. Harvest all merchantable spruce and fir. Sever all hardwood stems 2 inches and larger. Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Sale is located on a mix of sand and clay soils where wet spots and seepages are present. There are a number of small exclusions marked out because they are wet areas. Bayfield County may restrict logging during periods when soil is too wet to operate, as determined by Bayfield County.
- The blue line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the blue paint line.
- This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- Do not damage any survey monuments.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
