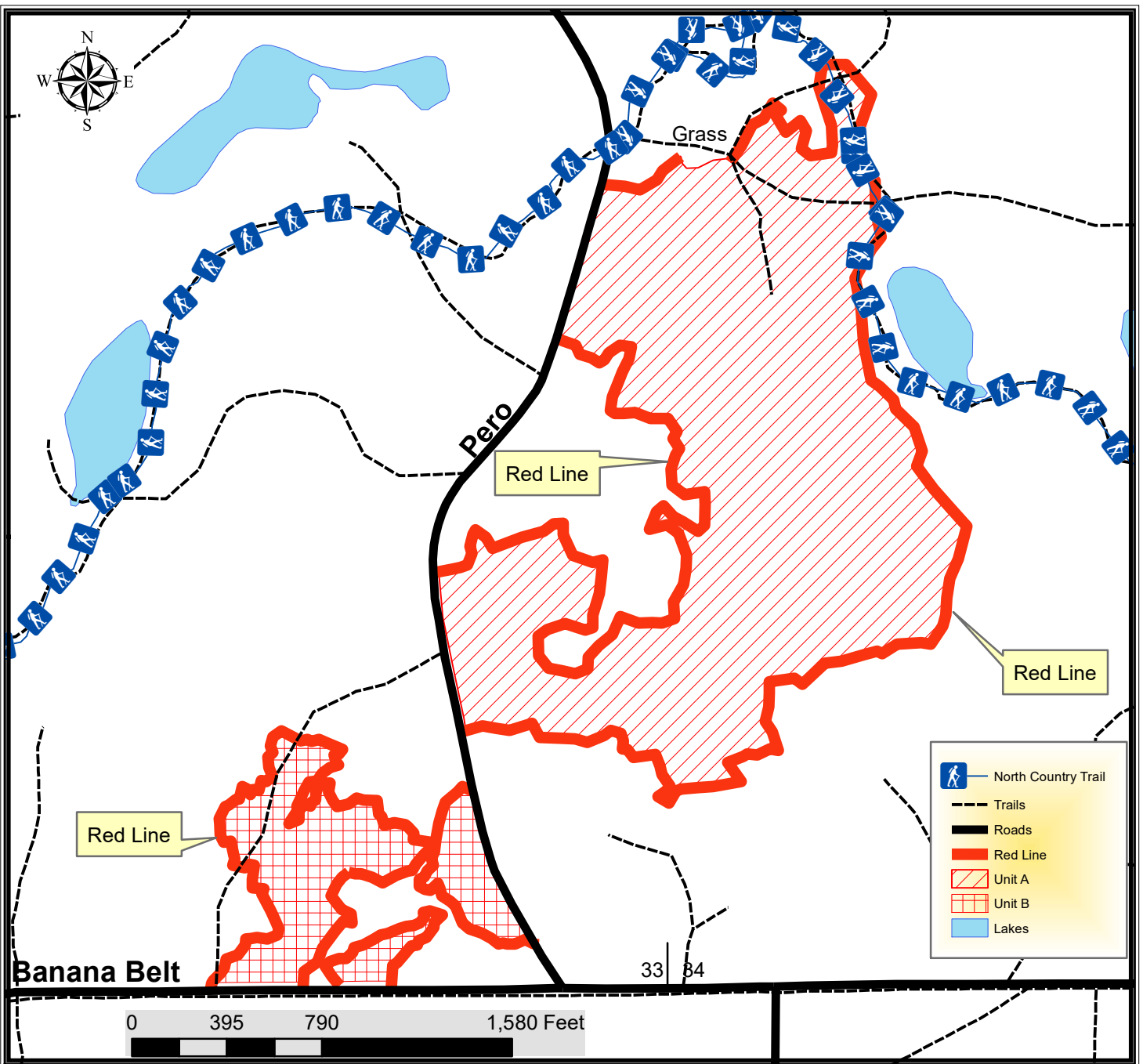

TRACT 13-21 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

- Harvest unit A has a coppice and thinning prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 26 and 127 ft² respectively.
- Harvest unit B has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft².

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

- In unit A, harvest all unmarked hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater and all orange marked conifer.
- In unit A, leave all unmarked conifer and purple marked hardwood stems.
- In unit B, harvest all stems 2" in diameter and greater.

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line and abrupt type change to grass.
- Portions of this sale are adjacent to the North Country Trail.
 - Do not cut blue painted trees that mark the location of the NCT
 - The NCT must be kept in good condition at all times and left free of slash and debris.
 - Slash must be kept within 12 inches of the ground within 25 ft of the NCT. No Slash may be left on the trail.
 - No hauling or skidding will be allowed on the NCT except for a single crossing point that will be designated by the sale administrator.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

E. OTHER:

- This sale includes 6 trees that are marked with a purple "X". Operator must fell and leave all trees marked with a purple "X". "X" marked trees should be cut 5 ft above ground level and should lie as close to the high stump as possible. These trees will create ruffed grouse drumming habitat.
- Utilization specification is to a 4" top. However, if the County determines that pulpwood markets continue to be very poor at the time of harvest the County will sign a contract amendment with the purchaser changing the utilization specification to a 5" top for selected species. When determining condition of the market, the County will pay particular attention to the amount of wood being purchased by the mills in Wisconsin Rapids and any other significant shifts in wood demand
- To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
