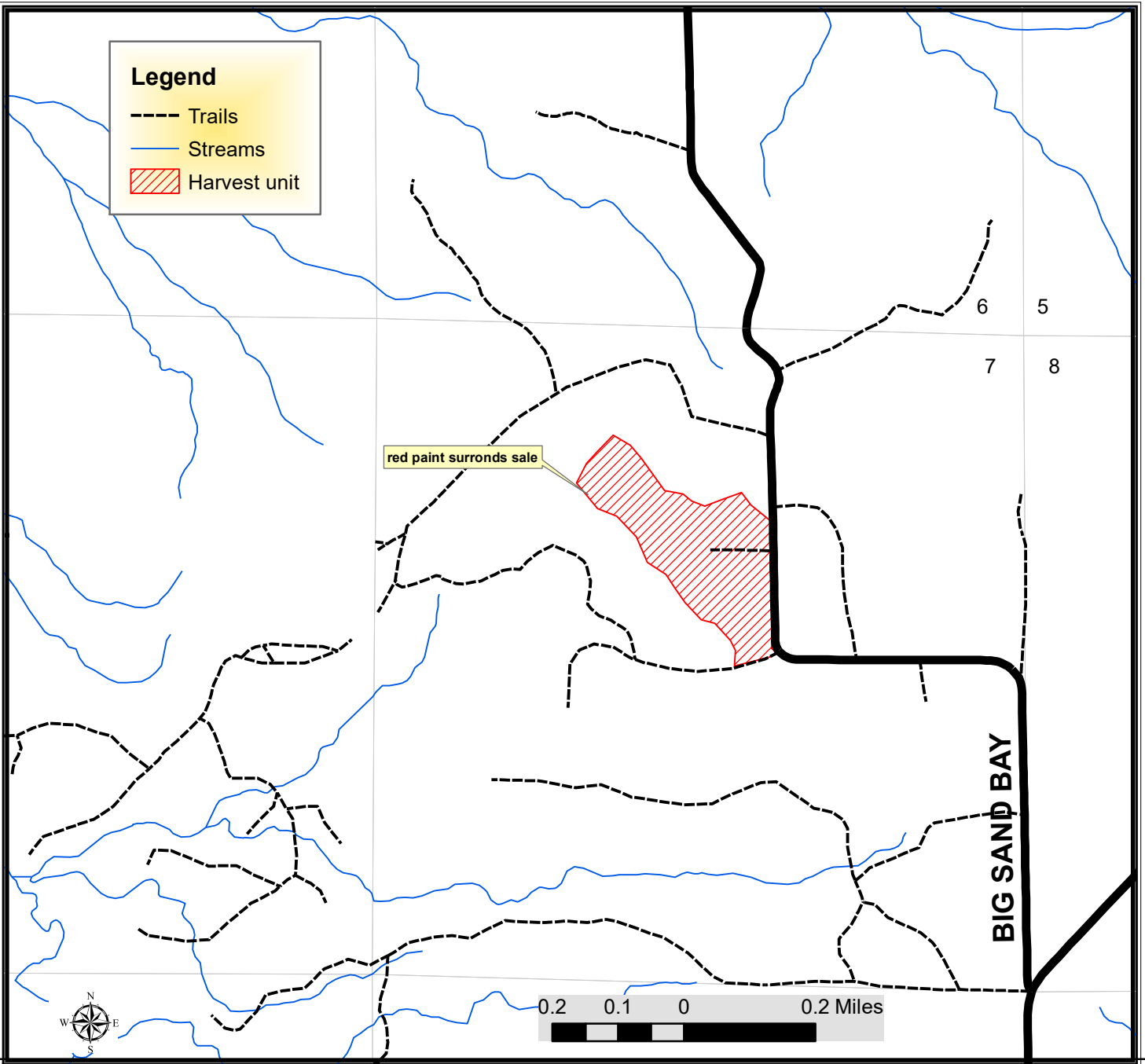

TRACT 31-21 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. Harvest unit 1 has a thinning prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 87 ft².

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

1. Unit 1: Harvest all orange painted trees and all white birch greater than 6 inches. Harvest all root sprung trees.

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

1. No harvesting between April 15 and July 15 to minimize two-lined chestnut borer damage.
2. Sale boundaries consist of red paint line and the town road.
3. Damage to residual trees must be minimized.
4. If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

1. Access is off Big Sand Bay Rd. There is stub road that goes west off Big Sand Bay rd. roughly in the middle of the unit.

E. OTHER:

1. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical. not damage any survey monumentation.
