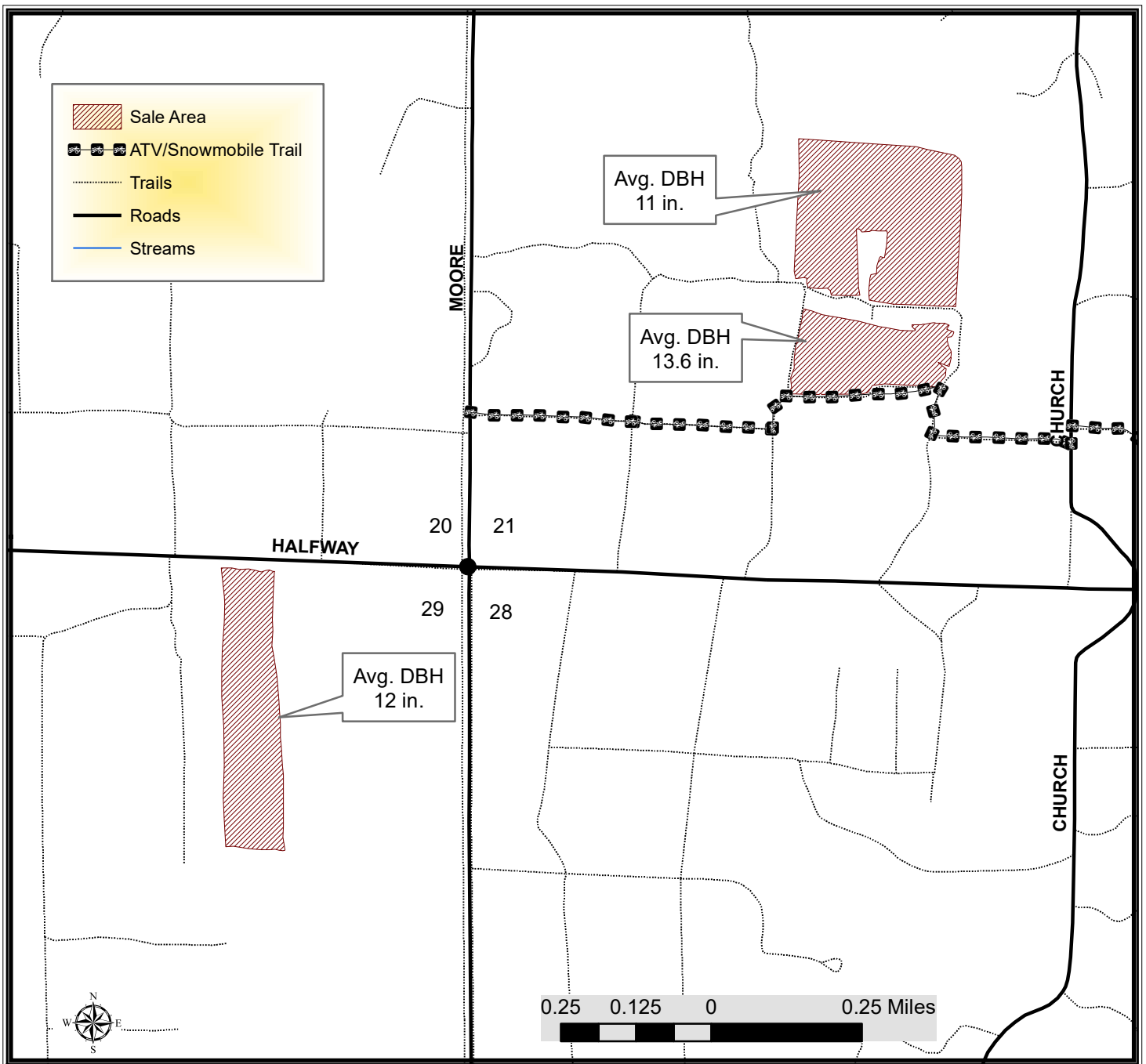

## TRACT 01-22 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

### A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. Harvest unit has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft<sup>2</sup>.

### B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

1. Harvest all trees 2" in diameter and greater within the sale area.
2. Cut all snags.

### C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

1. Sale boundaries consist of roads, trails and abrupt timber type changes to jack pine or young scrub oak.
2. No skidding or hauling will be allowed on the ATV/Snowmobile trail indicated on the map.
3. Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>.
4. If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.

### D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

1. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
2. Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

### E. OTHER:

1. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
2. Do not damage any survey monumentation.
